Selection Criteria

1. Knowledge of, and experience in delivering, the Australian Steiner Curriculum Framework for Class 2. Or a genuine interest in engaging in further learning to develop these understandings.
2. Sound understanding of child development and Steiner pedagogy or a genuine willingness to engage in further learning to develop this.
3. A demonstrated understanding of how to integrate differentiated learning for children with different learning needs in all lessons.
4. A demonstrated commitment to working collaboratively and professionally with colleagues.
5. A demonstrated commitment to ongoing professional learning.
6. A demonstrated emotional intelligence and professionalism in communications with children, colleagues, parents and the wider community.
7. A cultivation of artistic capacities to enable delivery of the content of the Australian Steiner Curriculum Framework, or a genuine commitment to developing them.

In addition, the successful applicant will need to possess:

- a) Current registration with the Teachers Registration Board of Western Australia.
- b) Western Australian Working With Children Check.
- c) Current First Aid Certificate

Applications will need to include:

- c) Written responses to the Selection Criteria (as outlined above)
